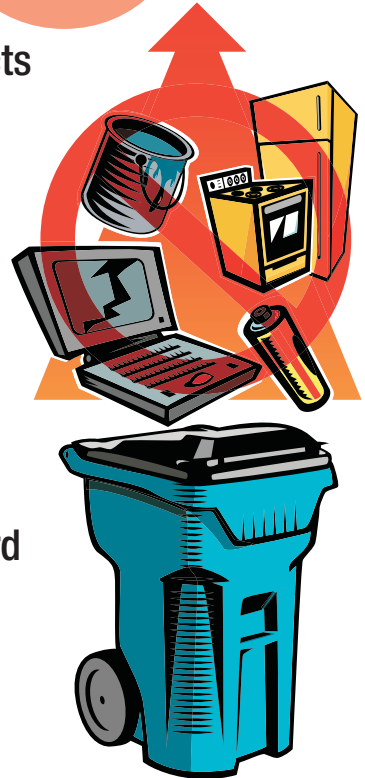

- All clean plastic containers
- All clean polystyrene (*styrofoam*) cups & containers
- All mixed and colored paper
- Brown paper bags
- Bag in bag (*film plastics and plastic bags*)
- Cans/Metal, aluminum, steel & tin
- Cardboard (*flattened and put into the bin*)
- Magazines
- Metal coat hangers
- Newspaper
- Office paper
- Pizza Boxes
- Plastic grocery bags
- Unwanted mail
