Reusable equipment can be obtained for free or at a minimal cost to the recipient.

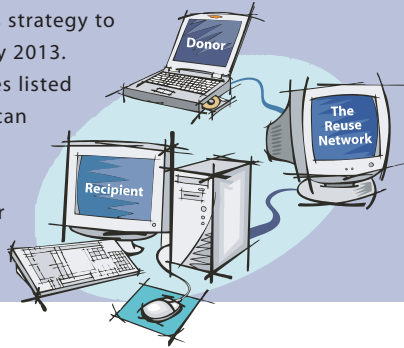


California State Law requires that all cities divert 50% of their solid waste stream by the year 2000.

The City of Los Angeles in its efforts to reduce solid waste disposal has exceeded the 50% goal and is now aiming for the 75% diversion of solid waste by the year 2013.

WHAT IS THE REUSE NETWORK?

It is a part of the City's strategy to reach 75% diversion by 2013. Through the businesses listed in this brochure, you can direct your unwanted office equipment to non-profit agencies for further reuse.



THE GOAL

The reuse network will establish a link between local business and reuse agencies, and develop a reuse program into a self-expanding sustainable program. This is a cost-effective way to assist the City of Los Angeles in meeting its solid waste diversion goals with your support and participation.

This program will also assist local businesses, organizations and institutions to find alternatives to the disposal of valuable materials which are presently discarded as waste.
