The installation of **14,300** catch basin screen covers and **7,400** catch basin inserts Citywide completes Phase I and Phase II of a three-phase project to improve water quality in Los Angeles. This program, funded by Proposition O, will significantly cut the amount of litter flowing into our creeks, rivers and beaches.

Projects funded by Proposition O help the City of Los Angeles move a step closer towards a healthy environment. Passed by an overwhelming majority in 2004, Proposition O currently finances projects that protect public health by cleaning up and preventing pollution in our regional waterways, as well as providing flood protection and increasing water conservation.

Prop O is supported by the Bureau of Sanitation, Bureau of Engineering and Los Angeles Stormwater Program.
