



North Outfall Sewer Rehabilitation Unit 13 Forney Street to Duvall Street NOTICE OF UPCOMING SEWER CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

Background

LA Sanitation & Environment is rehabilitating a portion of the North Outfall Sewer (NOS) on Blake Avenue in the public right-of-way. This will include repairs to the existing sewer line as well as cleaning of the sewer line and replacement or repair of maintenance holes. The City's sewer system requires regular maintenance, which may include cleaning, repair, rehabilitation, and replacement. These sewers are important because they carry wastewater to the Hyperion Water Reclamation Plant in Playa del Rey. This project will increase reliability of the sewer system and protect the environment for decades to come.

Summary

As part of the sewer line construction, activities will occur on Blake Avenue between Forney Street and Duvall Street. Construction activities will include:

- Utility relocation
- Pavement demolition
- Excavation and shoring
- Open-cut trenching
- Sewer access points (pits)
- Pipeline installation
- Construction of new maintenance holes
- Restoration of construction work areas

Time and Location

Time: Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
Saturday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., if required

When: Spring 2019 through Fall 2020

Where: Blake Street between Forney Street and Duvall Street

Additional Construction Information

- Through traffic maintained at all times except for local access only between Oros Street and Barclay Street
- During work hours one lane of traffic may be closed, with all lanes reopened from 3:30 pm to 9:00 pm
- Installation and operation of odor control unit
- Installation and operation of sewer bypass system
- Temporary "No Parking" in the construction work zone with advance notification
- Driveway, trash and delivery access will be maintained at all times

- Schedule is subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances.
