Venice Dual Force Main Sewer Project NOTICE OF UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

Background

LA Sanitation & Environment is building a new 54-inch diameter pressurized sewer line from Venice to the Hyperion Water Reclamation Plant in Playa del Rey to replace the existing 50-year-old sewer line.

What to Expect

As part of the sewer line construction, it is necessary to connect the sewer line to the diversion structure at Waterview Street. The project site preparation and setup will include:

- Three lanes of traffic on Vista del Mar will remain open at all times
- Traffic on Vista del Mar between Waterview and Napoleon Streets will be moved to the east side
- Northbound traffic will become one lane at Waterview Street for 1,500 feet, from south of Napoleon Street to Surf Street
- Southbound traffic will remain two lanes on Vista del Mar
- No parking on both sides of Vista del Mar near the traffic control area

Time and Location

Where: Vista del Mar between south of Napoleon Street and Surf Street

When: Saturday, September 7, 2019 through summer 2020

Work Hours: On-going construction on Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Implementation on Saturday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Additional Construction Information

- Through traffic will be maintained at all times
- Driveway, trash and delivery access will be maintained

- Project Construction: Spring 2017 through Summer 2020 – Schedule is subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances
