



North Outfall Sewer Unit 10 Rehabilitation PROJECT FACT SHEET



Project Information

The City of Los Angeles Department of Public Works will soon begin construction of a sewer project in your neighborhood. This project includes a number of improvements that will make your sewers more reliable for decades to come. The project may involve removing, repairing or rehabilitating sewer pipelines to address deterioration. The North Outfall Sewer, which has served Los Angeles since the 1920's, is in poor condition and in need of repair. This project will rehabilitate 5,018 feet of sewer pipe in addition to the repair & installation of maintenance holes and and installation of bypass structures.

What to Expect During Construction

- Lane closures on Gibbons Street and others when necessary to ensure safety
- "No Parking" areas on Gibbons Street and others with advanced notice
- Local access will be maintained at all times
- Access to at least 1 sidewalk will be maintained at all times
- Trucks and other equipment such as pipes will be used during construction
- Pits (access points)
- Excavation, shoring, slip lining, and/or open cut
- Repair, replacement and/or construction of sewer pipeline and maintenance holes
- You may experience odors during construction, this is normal and odors will cease upon completion
- Noise, dust and vibration as associated with this type of construction; mitigation measures will be in place
- Driveway, trash and delivery access will be maintained at all times
- Schedule is subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances
- **This project is still in design phase; changes to the design may occur prior to construction start date**
