Attention: As we continue to observe best practices to limit in person contact, and staff continues to telecommute, we ask that you please NOT attempt to visit the building to drop off your permit renewal in person. The online renewal using the LASAN Solid Resources Haulers and Facilities Portal is preferred.

If you do not have access to a scanner, you may take a photo of each page and email them to the above email address. Please be sure that the photos are clear and in focus, and that they show the entire page you are emailing.

The Solid Waste Hauler Permits issued for 2022-23 will expire on June 30, 2023. Permit Renewal Applications for the July 2023 to June 2024 permit year are due to the City of Los Angeles, LA Sanitation and Environment on or before April 30, 2023.

In order for a Permit Renewal Application to be deemed complete, haulers must abide by the Permit Renewal Application requirements listed below. Failure to abide by the following Permit Renewal Application requirements may lead to permit revocation effective July 1, 2023:

- Solid Waste Hauler/Contractor Permit Application All haulers/contractors must complete, sign, and submit a hard copy or complete an online renewal application. A blank copy is enclosed for your convenience. Please email to: <u>AB939Haulers@lacity.org</u>.
- Waste Hauler/Contractor Tonnage and Gross Receipts Reporting All haulers/contractors must be current with quarterly reports, up to and including the report for the quarter ending March 31, 2023.
- AB939 Compliance Fees All haulers/contractors that hauled over 1,000 tons of mixed solid waste and/or mixed C&D in 2022, or that expect to exceed 1,000 tons in 2023 must be current with AB939 Compliance Fees, up to and including any fees due for the quarter ending March 31, 2023.

## recycLA PROGRAM

<u>Senate Bill 1383</u> – In 2016 the State of California implemented Senate Bill 1383, "Short-lived Climate Pollutants Reduction Act," which requires local jurisdictions like the City to begin monitoring and enforcing the diversion of Organics (e.g., food waste, green waste, non-hazardous wood waste, and food-soiled paper waste that is mixed in with food waste) by January 1, 2022. In response, the City adopted Ordinance No. 187711 to implement the state-mandated organics program effective January 18, 2023.

Mixed C&D Waste Collection in the City — All mixed C&D waste generated within the City must be delivered only to City-certified C&D waste processors. Penalties of up to \$5,000 may be assessed for each load of unlawfully-disposed C&D waste. It is your responsibility to know the certification status of the facilities you utilize. To obtain a current list of City-certified C&D waste processors, go to <a href="https://www.lacitysan.org/haulerpermit">www.lacitysan.org/haulerpermit</a>. Make sure to visit this site frequently, since the list is subject to change without notice.

Residential Mixed Solid Waste Collection in the City – In accordance with the terms and conditions of your permit, the issuance of a Solid Waste Hauler Permit does not authorize the permit holder to collect, remove, or transport household refuse (as defined at LAMC Section 66.0) from any dwelling unit (as defined at LAMC Section 66.0) that receives refuse collection service from the City of Los Angeles.
