RECYCLE YOUR USED OIL

The City of Los Angeles offers 7 permanent S.A.F.E Centers that accept used oil, used oil filters, batteries and automotive fluids free of charge. Visit lacitysan.org/safecenters for more information.

COLLECT USED OIL

Always use a drip pan. Soak up any spills using absorbent material and dispose of it properly.

USE A CLEAN CONTAINER

Don't mix used car fluids together. Use a clean container for each one.

SHUT OFF THE HOSE

Wash your car with biodegradable soap and use as little water as possible.
