



Venice Dual Force Main Sewer Project NOTICE OF UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION SITE REMOVAL

Dear Resident,

The Venice Dual Force Main Sewer Project team is pleased to share an exciting project update! Construction work in your neighborhood has been completed and the construction work area will be vacated by the contractor. Move-out activities are anticipated to be completed by Wednesday, November 27, 2019.

As you know, LA Sanitation & Environment is building a new 54-inch diameter pressurized sewer line from Venice to the Hyperion Water Reclamation Plant in Playa del Rey to replace the existing 50-year-old sewer line.

As part of this construction project, a shaft location was constructed in your neighborhood at Hurricane Street and Esplanade. This shaft allowed for underground micro tunneling to install sewer pipe between this location and another shaft location at Via Dolce and Marquesas Way. In addition to the pipeline construction, a generator replacement project is being completed at the Venice Pumping Plant.

Sewer pipeline construction activities have now been completed at this location, and the generator replacement component is in the final stages. As such, the construction work area will be shut down and vacated. This will include removal of sound walls and equipment, as well as restoration of the original walking path. Large construction trucks and cranes will be required for the move-out activities.

Chain link fencing will be installed around the perimeter upon removal of the sound walls and restoration of the walking path. As final work is being completed on the generator replacement project inside of the Venice Pumping Plant, construction crew trucks will enter and exit the site via the chain link fence gate on Hurricane Street.

The chain link fencing will remain in place until commencement of construction for the Venice Auxiliary Pumping Plant Project (VAPP). VAPP is currently in the permitting process and does not have a scheduled start date at this time, although it is anticipated to begin sometime in early 2021.
