



Temporary Fence Removal and Restricted Access Zone

Background Information

LA Sanitation and Environment, working in conjunction with the Bureau of Engineering, will construct the Hyperion Perimeter Road Improvement Project. The project will further stabilize the private hillside service road adjacent to the Hyperion Water Reclamation Plant. This project is very important in maintaining Hyperion's access route around the facility for years to come. The City's contractor is coordinating with the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) to access their service road adjacent to the Hyperion hillside service road. Additionally, the contractor has provided an update on their planned construction activities, as outlined below.

Updated Construction Activities

The following activities are now expected to occur:

- Temporary fence removal near Hyperion's entrance gate during work hours
- Temporary restricted access zone on the LADWP service road adjacent to the Hyperion's entrance gate during work hours

Project Timeline

When: Spring 2022 – Summer 2023

Where: Hyperion Water Reclamation Plant Perimeter Road

What to Expect

- Work hours: Monday through Friday, 7:00am 4:00pm (deliveries to begin at 8:00am each work day)
- Sections of fencing near the Hyperion entrance gate will be temporarily removed during work hours
- Hyperion perimeter road will be secured during non-work hours
- To maintain the safety of the contractor's crew and the community, the LADWP service road adjacent to the Hyperion entrance gate will need to be intermittently restricted with temporary fencing during work hours to assist with deliveries and construction activities
- Traffic control will be implemented and will include a flag person to assist with deliveries and with trucks accessing the LADWP and Hyperion service roads
- The LADWP service road will be utilized in a one-way direction; for example, vehicles accessing this road from Grand Avenue will exit using Imperial Highway
- Noise monitoring devices will be utilized throughout the project
- Dust control measures will involve watering down Hyperion and LADWP service roads, as needed
- Vibration is not expected, but may potentially occur
- Residential streets are not impacted
- Project map is on the back for reference
- Schedule is subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances
