Project Information

The Hyperion Water Reclamation Plant (HWRP) Headworks & Large Diameter Sewer Cleaning project is a crucial project for the upkeep of the HWRP and surrounding sewer. This project will clean the Headworks facility inside the HWRP, as well as cleaning the large diameter sewer on Vista del Mar and Imperial Highway, adjacent to the plant. This project will clean and maintain these facilities, which will safeguard against future issues and overflows, and make the system more reliable for decades to come. As part of this sewer project, the contractor will conduct the following activities near you:

Construction Activities

The construction activities will consist of two (2) main portions. The first phase will involve the cleaning of sewer lines and structures immediately outside of the Hyperion plant:

- Daily setup of job site and temporary traffic control
- Cleaning of the sewer lines and structures, and removal of debris
- Daily removal of temporary traffic control

Work Schedule and Location

Time: Monday-Friday, 7:00am-4:00pm

When: Work on Phase 1 will begin in late August, 2022 and is anticipated to be completed by mid-October, 2022

Where: Vista del Mar, between Imperial Highway & Grand Avenue

What you need to know

- Vista del Mar will be reduced by one lane in each direction as needed, between Imperial Highway & Grand
 Avenue during work hours only. These temporary traffic control measures are necessary for safety, and will
 be set up and removed each day.
- Temporary "No Parking" areas in the work zone with advanced notice
- You may see large machinery, trucks, and construction crew members
- This is the first portion of our work. Another notice will be posted with information on the second portion
- Driveway, trash, sidewalk, and delivery access will be maintained at all times
- Schedule is subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances
