Response to Comment PHCS3-1

Comment noted. Refer to response to City of Burbank comments - AJ1, AJ13, AJ22, AJ30, AJ31, AJ32, and AJ36. As it relates to the GBIS North Alignment, as addressed in Section 3.12 of the Draft EIR, the construction of the proposed sewer component would be consistent with the goals and policies of all applicable plans, including the Los Angeles River Master Plan. Operation of permanent aboveground structures (i.e., ATFs) within designated open space or public facilities would not be a conforming use and would require a Conditional Use Permit (CUP). Therefore, the successful issuance of a CUP would reduce land use consistency impacts to less than significant. However, as addressed in Section 1.5.2.2 of this Final EIR, the staff recommended GBIS Alignment does not include a shaft site or ATF at Valley Heart/Pollywog.

As adequately addressed in Section 3.5 (page 3.5-34) of the Draft EIR, in the event that construction impacts to the native trees at the Riverside East Shaft Site cannot be avoided, preservation would be attempted. If preservation is not appropriate, impact to the trees would be mitigated with implementation of mitigation measure BIO-MM-5, and no significant impact would occur to the character of the Bette Davis Park. As addressed in Section 1.5.2.2 of this Final EIR, the staff recommended GBIS Alignment does not include construction at the Riverside East site. In addition, refer to response to comment AJ1-10 regarding potential settlement impacts due to tunneling activities. To further minimize the potential for settlement impacts, mitigation measure GEO-MM-2 has been modified in this Final EIR (refer to Section 2) to add a goal to further limit surface settlement to 0.50-inch along the tunnel alignment.

1. The proposed permanent Air Treatment Facility in Pollywog would have a tremendous negative impact on the surrounding area; that kind of an industrial facility does not belong in a recreational park or anywhere near a residential area. It would be an extremely ugly addition to our beautiful, unique Rancho, and would bring with it unacceptable noise levels and odor problems.
2. The Pollywog is currently a wonderful park where residents can, and do, exercise their horses, their dogs and themselves. It functions as a local social gathering place, where neighbors meet and chat, while walking their dogs or training their horses. The closest home is less than 10 meters from Pollywog. I am sure that when home owners in the area purchased their houses, they did so partially because of the beautiful and "handy" little park at the corner of Reese and Valleyheart Drive. It surprises me that Pollywog is not listed in the Los Angeles Draft EIR as a recreational resource, considering it is part of Griffith Park and is being utilized on a daily basis for various recreational activities. Property values would most definitely plummet if the park suddenly turned into an ugly, smelly industrial facility!
3. Every resident in the Rancho area would be severely impacted by added noise, vibrations and heavy traffic during the construction phase of the project. The sound wall, just recently added to protect the area from freeway noise, would instead increase the noise level intolerably, by bouncing construction noises and vibrations back into the neighborhood. The noise and vibrations would not only decrease our property values, but would make daily life intolerable for all residents, including horses, dogs and cats.
4. The many trips daily (100+?!) by construction vehicles up and down our streets would make the area unsafe. Already, driving down Valleyheart Drive can be like driving an obstacle course, with horses, riders, dogs, kids and bicycles all sharing the street with horse trailers and cars. I can not imagine how dangerous it would be to all concerned if we were to add heavy truck traffic into the mix on a daily basis. I would expect many accidents affecting spooked horses and kids on their bikes on Valleyheart Drive and neighboring streets.

The Burbank Rancho is currently a wonderful, beautiful neighborhood. Let's keep it that way!
