

Comment noted. The IRP Project Alternatives are intended to accommodate the wastewater needs anticipated by the year 2020. In addition, the Project Alternatives include various water recycling and runoff management components. Although the IRP does not include every possible water recycling or management technology, the components carried through the Draft EIR do not limit or hinder the City from further pursuing other alternatives or methods of water conservation or management such as those suggested by the commenter. In fact, LADWP continues to move forward with its aggressive water conservation program, including exploration of new conservation opportunities consistent with the goals of the IRP and the Urban Water Management Plan. It should be noted that several of the commenter's suggestions (onsite management via cisterns and percolation/storage at schools and government facilities and groundwater replenishment) are components of the IRP that were analyzed at a program-level in the Draft EIR.





Thank you for this opportunity to voice my concerns regarding the part of the Los Angeles Integrated Resources Plan Draft Environmental Impact Report (Draft EIR) that impacts me and my Rancho neighborhood in Burbank, specifically the Glendale-Burbank Integrated Sewer (GBIS).

Of the two alternative alignments you present, the **GBIS SOUTH ALIGNMENT** alternative is by far preferable as it will give you what you want with the least environmental impact on far fewer people.

By choosing the **SOUTH ALIGNMENT** alternative you will preserve the Valley Heart Pollywog for the community to exercise our horses and walk our dogs. Our children can continue to breathe air that is free from the unhealthy stench of an air treatment facility in the Valley Heart Pollywog. And the many miles of neighborhoods, built up to a high level of quality through years of investment and hard work, will be saved from the devaluation that would inevitably result from such a sewer project.

Response to Comment PHCS88-1

Large-diameter sewers in the City of Los Angeles have a life span that generally ranges from 50 to 100 years.

Response to Comment PHCS88-2

Purchase of some parcels may be required depending upon which Project Alternative is approved for implementation. Easements across parcels not owned by the City of Los Angeles, as applicable, would be obtained for Project components. As detailed in Section 3.14 of the Draft EIR, a majority of new facilities and improvements associated with the Project Alternatives would be constructed within existing public rights-of-way and on publicly owned property. Possible exceptions include proposed facilities associated with the NEIS II and GBIS components, such as the Verdant Street Shaft Site/drop structure/ATF, Brazil Street Shaft Site/ATF, Barham Shaft Site, and drop structure at Vineland Avenue near Riverside Drive or Moorpark Street. In addition, program-level components, such as URPs and permanent structures associated with the VSLIS, could be located on privately owned property. The program-level components will be subject to additional future environmental analysis and review at such time that project-specific information is available.

Response to Comment PHCS88-3

Some trenching will be required to construct diversion structures and connecting sewers as part of the NEIS II and GBIS components. The staff recommended GBIS Alignment described in Section 1.5.2.2 of this Final EIR would use the western portion of the GBIS North Alignment in Riverside Drive. As discussed in the Draft EIR, this alignment would require open-trench construction in Vineland Avenue in the vicinity of Riverside Drive. In addition, maintenance hole structures will require surface construction along the alignments approximately every 2,500 feet.

If it's a matter of yes or no, it's a "No." I am against your proposals as they were presented last night.



In regards to the proposed GBIS (Glendale Burbank Interceptor Sewer), it seems to me that the southern alignment tunneling route would have impact fewer private dwellings than the proposed northern alignment & should be given greater consideration because of this.

The Air Treatment Facility proposed for the northern route at the intersection of Reese Pl. & Valleyheart would impact a great number of private homes with unmistakable foul odors. The inconvenience of residents & commuters with temporary traffic congestion & noise during construction is a regrettable yet understandable sacrifice for progress. But a permanent odor that will penetrate into private homes is quite another matter and should be avoided at all costs. No one deserves that stench in their own living room. And I fear that we don't fully understand the health risks in long term exposure to such a facility, especially the area's children & elderly. Please do whatever is necessary to keep such Air Treatment Facilities out of residential neighborhoods.



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Recently, public hearings were held for a major sewer project proposal called the **Integrated Resources Plan (IRP)**. Many members of our community may not have received notice of this proposed project or subsequent hearings. Prepared by the city, the EIR Report for this plan focuses heavily on the Toluca Lake community and is fraught with major issues which could affect us for many years.

One alternative (the GBIS **South Alignment**) begins near the L. A. Zoo, continues down Forest Lawn Drive, to Barham Blvd, then west beneath the Los Angeles river (through Lakeside Golf Club) onto Valley Spring Lane, then north along the 101, west along Moorpark ending at or near Woodbridge Park (This is an approximate route.)

The second alternative (the GBIS North Alignment) proposes a route from the L. A. Zoo, through the Rancho neighborhood of Burbank, then west on Riverside Drive and again ending at or near Woodbridge Park. (This is an approximate route.) The residents of Burbank have sent hundreds of letters in opposition to this alternative and have the support of the Mayor of Burbank and the Burbank City Council to push this project into our community (South Alignment)

The proposed project is major construction and would significantly impact our neighborhood for many, many months ... perhaps years. These impacts will include, but would not be limited to:

- air quality (sewage odors and pollutants)
- ground settlement near homes and in streets
- noise and vibration
- excessive traffic
- possible declining property values.

The proposal includes tunneling in most areas and above ground in others. Single family homes and occupants will be affected.

It is critical for all of us to voice our concerns to Councilman Tom LaBonge and to insist the City of Los Angeles put more effort into finding another alternative that will upgrade the city's sewer infrastructure without having a detrimental and disruptive effect on our neighborhoods. **The existing L.A. River south of the river right-of-way to Woodbridge Park is a viable alternative (the EIR already proposes a section of the route beneath the river).**
